Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act is amended by adding Section 3.4 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 625/3.4 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3.4. Home kitchen operation.</u>
- (a) For the purpose of this Section, "home kitchen operation" means a person who produces or packages non-potentially hazardous food in a kitchen of that person's primary domestic residence for direct sale by the owner or a family member, or for sale by a religious, charitable, or nonprofit organization, stored in the residence where the food is made. The following conditions must be met in order to
- 15 qualify as a home kitchen operation:
- 16 (1) Monthly gross sales do not exceed \$1,000.
- 17 (2) The food is not a potentially hazardous baked food,
 18 as defined in Section 4 of this Act.
- 19 <u>(3) A notice is provided to the purchaser that the</u> 20 product was produced in a home kitchen.
- 21 <u>(b) The Department of Public Health or the health</u>
 22 <u>department of a unit of local government may inspect a home</u>
 23 kitchen operation in the event of a complaint or disease

- 1 outbreak.
- 2 (c) This Section applies only to a home kitchen operation
- located in a municipality, township, or county where the local 3
- governing body has adopted an ordinance authorizing the direct 4
- sale of baked goods as described in Section 4 of this Act. 5
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
