#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 335/12  
625 ILCS 5/6-118

from Ch. 124, par. 32

Amends the Illinois Identification Card Act. Provides that the fee for an original, renewal, or duplicate Standard Illinois Identification Card shall be reduced to \$10 for veterans. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the fee for an original or renewal driver's license shall be reduced to \$15 for veterans. Effective January 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Identification Card Act is amended  
5 by changing Section 12 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 335/12) (from Ch. 124, par. 32)

7 Sec. 12. Fees concerning Standard Illinois Identification  
8 Cards. The fees required under this Act for standard Illinois  
9 Identification Cards must accompany any application provided  
10 for in this Act, and the Secretary shall collect such fees as  
11 follows:

13 All fees collected under this Act shall be paid into the  
14 Road Fund of the State treasury, except that the following  
15 amounts shall be paid into the General Revenue Fund: (i) 80% of  
16 the fee for an original, renewal, or duplicate Illinois  
17 Identification Card issued on or after January 1, 2005; and  
18 (ii) 80% of the fee for a corrected Illinois Identification  
19 Card issued on or after January 1, 2005.

20 An individual, who resides in a veterans home or veterans  
21 hospital operated by the state or federal government, who makes  
22 an application for an Illinois Identification Card to be issued  
23 at no fee, must submit, along with the application, an  
24 affirmation by the applicant on a form provided by the  
25 Secretary of State, that such person resides in a veterans home  
26 or veterans hospital operated by the state or federal

1 government.

2 The application of a homeless individual for an Illinois  
3 Identification Card to be issued at no fee must be accompanied  
4 by an affirmation by a qualified person, as defined in Section  
5 4C of this Act, on a form provided by the Secretary of State,  
6 that the applicant is currently homeless as defined in Section  
7 1A of this Act.

8 The fee for any duplicate identification card shall be  
9 waived for any person who presents the Secretary of State's  
10 Office with a police report showing that his or her  
11 identification card was stolen.

12 The fee for any duplicate identification card shall be  
13 waived for any person age 60 or older whose identification card  
14 has been lost or stolen.

15 As used in this Section, "active-duty member of the United  
16 States Armed Forces" means a member of the Armed Services or  
17 Reserve Forces of the United States or a member of the Illinois  
18 National Guard who is called to active duty pursuant to an  
19 executive order of the President of the United States, an act  
20 of the Congress of the United States, or an order of the  
21 Governor.

5 In order to ensure the proper implementation of the Uniform  
6 Commercial Driver License Act, Article V of this Chapter, the  
7 Secretary of State is empowered to pro-rate the \$24 fee for the  
8 commercial driver's license proportionate to the expiration  
9 date of the applicant's Illinois driver's license.

10 The fee for any duplicate license or permit shall be waived  
11 for any person who presents the Secretary of State's office  
12 with a police report showing that his license or permit was  
13 stolen.

14 The fee for any duplicate license or permit shall be waived  
15 for any person age 60 or older whose driver's license or permit  
16 has been lost or stolen.

17 No additional fee shall be charged for a driver's license,  
18 or for a commercial driver's license, when issued to the holder  
19 of an instruction permit for the same classification or type of  
20 license who becomes eligible for such license.

21 (b) Any person whose license or privilege to operate a  
22 motor vehicle in this State has been suspended or revoked under  
23 Section 3-707, any provision of Chapter 6, Chapter 11, or  
24 Section 7-205, 7-303, or 7-702 of the Family Financial

15 revoked for a second or subsequent time for a violation of

17 the Criminal Code of 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012,  
18 \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license  
19 summarily suspended under Section 11-501.1, and \$190 of the  
20 \$500 fee for reinstatement of a revoked license shall be  
21 deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention  
22 Fund. \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license  
23 summarily revoked pursuant to Section 11-501.1 shall be  
24 deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention  
25 Fund.

26 3. \$6 of such original or renewal fee for a commercial

1 driver's license and \$6 of the commercial driver  
2 instruction permit fee when such permit is issued to any  
3 person holding a valid Illinois driver's license, shall be  
4 paid into the CDLIS/AAMVAnet/NMVTIS Trust Fund.

5 4. \$30 of the \$70 fee for reinstatement of a license  
6 suspended under the Family Financial Responsibility Law  
7 shall be paid into the Family Responsibility Fund.

8 5. The \$5 fee for each original or renewal M or L  
9 endorsement shall be deposited into the Cycle Rider Safety  
10 Training Fund.

11 6. \$20 of any original or renewal fee for a commercial  
12 driver's license or commercial driver instruction permit  
13 shall be paid into the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection  
14 Fund.

15 7. The following amounts shall be paid into the General  
16 Revenue Fund:

17 (A) \$190 of the \$250 reinstatement fee for a  
18 summary suspension under Section 11-501.1;

19 (B) \$40 of the \$70 reinstatement fee for any other  
20 suspension provided in subsection (b) of this Section;  
21 and

22 (C) \$440 of the \$500 reinstatement fee for a first  
23 offense revocation and \$310 of the \$500 reinstatement  
24 fee for a second or subsequent revocation.

25 (d) All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by  
26 this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly shall be

1 deposited into the Capital Projects Fund.

2 (e) The additional fees imposed by this amendatory Act of  
3 the 96th General Assembly shall become effective 90 days after  
4 becoming law.

5 (f) As used in this Section, "active-duty member of the  
6 United States Armed Forces" means a member of the Armed  
7 Services or Reserve Forces of the United States or a member of  
8 the Illinois National Guard who is called to active duty

8           \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license  
9           summarily suspended under Section 11-501.1, and \$190 of the  
10          \$500 fee for reinstatement of a revoked license shall be  
11          deposited into the Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention  
12          Fund. \$190 of the \$500 fee for reinstatement of a license

16                 3. \$6 of the original or renewal fee for a commercial  
17                 driver's license and \$6 of the commercial learner's permit

19                 Illinois driver's license, shall be paid into the  
20                 CDLIS/AAMVAnet/NMVTIS Trust Fund.

21                 4. \$30 of the \$70 fee for reinstatement of a license  
22                 suspended under the Family Financial Responsibility Law  
23                 shall be paid into the Family Responsibility Fund.

24                 5. The \$5 fee for each original or renewal M or L  
25                 endorsement shall be deposited into the Cycle Rider Safety  
26                 Training Fund.

1           6. \$20 of any original or renewal fee for a commercial  
2 driver's license or commercial learner's permit shall be  
3 paid into the Motor Carrier Safety Inspection Fund.

4           7. The following amounts shall be paid into the General  
5 Revenue Fund:

6           (A) \$190 of the \$250 reinstatement fee for a  
7 summary suspension under Section 11-501.1;

8           (B) \$40 of the \$70 reinstatement fee for any other  
9 suspension provided in subsection (b) of this Section;  
10 and

11           (C) \$440 of the \$500 reinstatement fee for a first  
12 offense revocation and \$310 of the \$500 reinstatement  
13 fee for a second or subsequent revocation.

14           (d) All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by  
15 this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly shall be  
16 deposited into the Capital Projects Fund.

17           (e) The additional fees imposed by this amendatory Act of  
18 the 96th General Assembly shall become effective 90 days after  
19 becoming law.

4 changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by text  
5 that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a Section  
6 represented by multiple versions), the use of that text does  
7 not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the changes  
8 made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any other  
9 Public Act.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January  
11 1, 2015.
