## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State may issue Blue Star Banner plates to residents of Illinois that have a spouse, parent, sibling, or child actively serving in the United States Armed Forces.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-699.14 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new)
- Sec. 3-699.14. Blue Star Banner license plates.
- (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Blue Star Banner license plates to residents of Illinois 11 who have a spouse, parent, sibling, or child actively serving 12 in the United States Armed Forces. The special Blue Star Banner 13 14 plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and 15 16 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 17 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by 18 19 Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
  - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with

- 1 <u>Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to</u>
- 2 designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of
- 3 <u>Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall, in his or her</u>
- 4 <u>discretion</u>, approve and prescribe stickers or decals as
- 5 provided under Section 3-412.
