1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5892

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 5892, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, as follows:

5 on page 2, after line 17, by adding the following:

6 "Standing protocol" may be issued by (i) a physician
7 licensed to practice medicine in all its branches, (ii) a
8 physician assistant who has been delegated the authority to
9 prescribe asthma medications or epinephrine auto-injectors by
10 his or her supervising physician, or (iii) an advanced practice
11 nurse who has a collaborative agreement with a collaborating
12 physician that delegates authority to issue a standing protocol
13 for asthma medications or epinephrine auto-injectors."; and

14 on page 5, line 10, after "physician", by inserting "L
15 physician assistant, or advanced practice nurse"; and

1 on page 8, line 13, after "authority", by inserting "for asthma
2 medication or epinephrine auto-injectors"; and

3 on page 8, line 14, by deleting "registered"; and

4 on page 8, line 15, after "authority", by inserting "for asthma
5 medication or epinephrine auto-injectors"; and

6 on page 9, line 19, by replacing "order" with "protocol"; and

7 on page 10, line 3, after the period, by inserting "The school
8 district, public school, or nonpublic school must maintain
9 records related to the training curriculum and trained
10 personnel."; and

11 on page 10, line 9, after "areas", by inserting "within the
12 school and its related facilities"; and

13 on page 12, by replacing lines 3 through 6 with the following:

14 "(1) A school district, public school, or nonpublic school
15 is encouraged not to use the administration of emergency
16 medications to reduce the number of school nurses in a school
17 or school district.".
