Amends the Pyrotechnic Use Act. Repeals a provision prohibiting the sale and use of fireworks. Provides that fireworks may only be discharged by individuals over the age of 18. Provides that fireworks may only be discharged between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. except on Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, and New Year's Eve.

Each consumer display shall be handled by a competent 15 individual who has received training from a consumer fireworks 16 17 training class approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshal. Applications for consumer display permits shall be 18 made in writing at least 15 days in advance of the date of the 19 display, unless agreed to otherwise by the local jurisdiction 20 issuing the permit and the fire chief of the jurisdiction in 21 which the display will occur. After a permit has been granted, 22 sales, possession, use, and distribution of consumer fireworks 23

- 1 for display shall be lawful for that purpose only. No permit
 2 granted hereunder shall be transferable.

Permits may be granted hereunder to any adult individual applying for a permit who provides proof that he or she has received the requisite training. The local jurisdiction issuing the permit is authorized to conduct a criminal background check of the applicant as a condition of issuing a permit.

9 A permit shall be issued only after inspection of the 10 display site by the fire chief providing fire protection 11 coverage to the area of display, or his or her designee, to 12 determine that the display is in full compliance with the rules 13 adopted by the State Fire Marshal. Nothing in this Section 14 shall prohibit the issuer of a permit from adopting more 15 stringent rules.
