2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6098, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the  
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
8 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General  
9 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
10 the Judicial Inquiry Board:

6 Defender Federal Trust Fund to the Office of the State  
7 Appellate Defender for expenses related to federally assisted  
8 programs to work on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases  
9 to which the agency is appointed.

10 Section 15. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for  
13 expenses related to federally assisted programs to work on  
14 systemic sentencing issues appeals cases to which the agency  
15 is appointed.

16 Section 20. The amount of \$175,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
18 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the  
19 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$63,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide  
 2 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public  
 3 Defender Training Program.

4 ARTICLE 3
