SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates $\$ 8,893,900$ from the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Fund to the Department of Corrections for the operation of a residential substance abuse treatment facility at the Murphysboro Correctional Center for FY15. Effective July 1, 2014.

Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the Department of Corrections from the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Fund for the operation of a residential substance abuse treatment facility located at the:

For Commodities ..... 600,000
For Printing ..... 3,000
For Equipment ..... 25,000

For Telecommunications Services ....................... 8,400
For Operation of Auto Equipment ....................... 12,000
