HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

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2	WHEREAS, Recent data indicates that Latinos represent
3	about 4% of individuals in the Prioritization for Urgency of
4	Need for Services (PUNS) list of residents who have been
5	screened and waiting for services relating to their
6	disabilities; and
7	WHEREAS, Latinos make up 16% of the general population in
8	the State of Illinois and 25% of the children under 18 in the
9	State; and
10	WHEREAS, The disparity between the State's Latino
11	population and Latino membership in the PUNS program indicates
12	significant barriers and unmet needs for services in the Latino
13	community; and
14	WHEREAS, There exists a great need for further study of the
15	State's policies concerning Latinos with disabilities;
16	therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
18	NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE
19	SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Latinos with Disabilities
20	Task Force is created to examine the current status of Latinos
21	with Disabilities in the State of Illinois and to advise the

- 1 General Assembly and the Governor on necessary improvements;
- 2 and be it further

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- 3 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall:
  - compile information regarding Latinos disabilities in the State of Illinois, including but not limited to incidence, prevalence, type of disability, access to services, participation in programming, and outcome data:
    - (2)consider any other available and relevant. information on Latinos with disabilities in Illinois, including but not limited community feedback, survey, or Census data:
    - (3) assess the responsiveness of the current and evolving delivery system of services for persons with disabilities in the Latino community, including barriers to participation;
      - (4) assess current health and human services system reform efforts; and
      - (5) identify and recommend specific best-practices and changes at the policy, structural, and programmatic level that can facilitate equitable Latino participation; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be composed of the 23 24 following members:

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1	(1) 3 members app	ointed by the G	Govern	or who	are persons	
2	with developmental	disabilities	or	their	immediate	
3	relatives or guardians;					

- (2) 3 members appointed by the Governor who are representatives of advocate organizations which are concerned with protecting the rights of persons with developmental disabilities;
- (3) 6 members appointed by the Governor who are representatives of provider agencies or research organizations; and
- 11 (4) One member appointed by the Secretary of the 12 Illinois Department of Human Services as a representative 13 of that office; and be it further
  - RESOLVED, That all members of the Task Force appointed by the Governor are to be appointed upon the recommendation of the Illinois Legislative Latino Caucus and the Illinois Latino Family Commission; the members of the Task Force shall elect a chairperson from among their membership; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That members of the Task Force shall serve 20 without compensation but shall be reimbursed for their 21 reasonable and necessary expenses from funds appropriated for 22 that purpose; and be it further
  - RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall receive administrative

- 1 support from the Illinois Latino Family Commission and the
- 2 Illinois Department of Human Services; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall submit its final report
- 4 and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly no
- 5 later than January 1, 2016.
