## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. I, Sec. 22.1 new

Proposes to amend the Bill of Rights Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that people have a right to hunt and fish as it is a valued part of our heritage and shall be forever preserved for the public good.

3	RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4	NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE
5	SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the
6	electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general
7	election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of
8	this resolution a proposition to amend Article I by adding
9	Section 22.1 as follows:
10	ARTICLE I
11	BILL OF RIGHTS
12	(ILCON Art. I, Sec. 22.1 new)
13	SECTION 22.1. RIGHT TO HUNT AND FISH
14	The people have a right to hunt and fish as it is a valued
15	part of our heritage and shall be forever preserved for the
16	public good, subject only to the laws prescribed by the General
17	Assembly and rules prescribed by the virtue of the authority of
18	the General Assembly. Hunting and fishing shall be the
19	preferred means of managing and controlling wildlife. This
20	Section shall not be construed to limit the application of any
21	provision of law relating to trespass or property rights.
