1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to recognize the 5th anniversary of the 4 Smokefree Illinois Act and to proclaim the month of January as 5 Smokefree Illinois Month; and

WHEREAS, Secondhand smoke is a major health hazard and there is no risk-free level of exposure to secondhand smoke; approximately 50,000 deaths each year are attributable to secondhand smoke exposure according to the U.S. Surgeon General, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the National Cancer Institute; and

WHEREAS, Separate smoking areas, air cleaning, or ventilation does not eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke; smokefree policies are the only effective protection from exposure to secondhand smoke and smokefree laws provide immediate health benefits, most notably a decline in heart attack hospitalizations; and

WHEREAS, Hospitalizations in Illinois for tobacco-related diseases have declined since the Smokefree Illinois Act was enacted; it is estimated that more than 35,000 heart disease hospitalizations among Illinois residents have been prevented because of the Smokefree Illinois Act, resulting in an

- 1 estimated savings of \$1.8 billion in hospital costs alone,
- 2 according to Illinois Department of Health data; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Smokefree Illinois Act protects all residents
- 4 and visitors regardless of where they work or play and it
- 5 attracts visitors from states with little or no protection from
- 6 secondhand smoke; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The health and economic benefits of the Illinois
- 8 Smokefree Act are widely recognized; therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 10 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 11 we recognize the 5th anniversary of the Smokefree Illinois Act
- 12 and proclaim the month of January as Smokefree Illinois Month
- 13 to remind the public about the benefits of protecting everyone
- 14 from the health risks associated with secondhand smoke and the
- importance of prohibiting smoking in all public places and
- workplaces; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 18 presented to the American Lung Association and the American
- 19 Cancer Society as an expression of our esteem and respect.
