1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, Someone develops Alzheimer's disease every 68 seconds; and
- WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is on the rise, with more than
 5 million Americans currently living with the disease and an
 6 estimated 16 million Americans projected to be diagnosed with
 7 the disease by 2050; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Currently, 210,000 people in Illinois live with 9 the disease; there will be an estimated 220,000 in 2020, and 240,000 in 15 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is an unrelenting, 12 progressive condition that destroys brain cells, with no 13 currently known cure; Alzheimer's places significant financial burdens on families and businesses, with businesses losing 14 billions a year in lost productivity and replacement expenses 15 for employees who miss work or quit to care for a relative; and 16
- 17 WHEREAS, In 2010, there were 579,505 Illinois family
 18 members and friends who provided over 700 million hours of
 19 unpaid care valued at \$7 billion to their loved ones with
 20 Alzheimer's and other dementias; and

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- 1 WHEREAS, The impact of Alzheimer's and other dementias on 2 Illinois families, the health care system, and society as a 3 whole is of great importance; the need for home and 4 community-based services for those with Alzheimer's is on the 5 rise and caregiver stress is at an all-time high; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is a looming public health
 7 crisis; we call upon all policymakers to join in the efforts to
 8 raise awareness and to serve the hundreds of thousands of
 9 persons with Alzheimer's and other dementias in Illinois, their
 10 families, and caregivers; and
