2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are honored to congratulate Cyril A. "Bud"

8 Farmington Community High School in 1949; and

9 WHEREAS, Bud Stobaugh began working for the Caterpillar
10 Tractor Company on February 6, 1950; he retired as a technical
11 writer in the Service Information Department in January of
12 1991, after 41 years of dedicated service; and

13 WHEREAS, Bud Stobaugh voluntarily enlisted in the United
14 States Air Force on April 4, 1951, and served during the Korean
15 War; he was honorably discharged on November 13, 1953, and held
16 the designation of inactive reserve for 8 years until the end
17 of the war; and

18 WHEREAS, Bud Stobaugh was a member of the Farmington City
19 Council and served as the City of Farmington Police
20 Commissioner for 8 years; he was elected to a 2-year term as
21 Mayor of Farmington on April 1, 2003, and served 2 four-year

1 terms; and

2 WHEREAS, Bud Stobaugh married Norma Jeanne Paine on July 3,
3 1954; together, they had 4 children, Michael, James, Patricia
4 (St. Tourangeau), and Timothy Stobaugh, and 6 grandchildren,
5 David Stobaugh, Sarah Stobaugh, Ryan Stobaugh, Rachel
6 Stobaugh, Erica Stobaugh, and Marc Tourangeau; therefore, be it
