- 2 dedicated himself to a career where he repaired and maintained
- 3 the many different machines that produce the Nabisco products
- 4 that are enjoyed by many throughout the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, William Janas has also been a member of Local 49
- 6 of the International Association of Machinists and volunteered
- 7 his time throughout the years as a steward and a member of the
- 8 contract negotiating committee; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Throughout his 40 years at the Nabisco Bakery,
- 10 William Janas worked countless hours of overtime, and through
- 11 this dedication and sacrifice, he and his wife, Patricia, were
- able to put their 2 children through college; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Despite the long hours he dedicated to his job,
- William Janas volunteered as a coach for many Darien Youth Club
- 15 soccer, basketball, and baseball teams and he is known amongst
- his friends, family, and neighbors for giving baskets full of
