HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The Norfolk Southern Railroad has multiple 3 at-grade crossings on the south side of Centralia, including 4 at-grade crossings at U.S. Route 51 for both northbound and 5 southbound traffic; and

6 WHEREAS, When trains block the crossings, the vehicle 7 delays are as long as 40 minutes and have caused problems for 8 emergency responders by delaying and extending their response 9 times; and

10 WHEREAS, Delays in providing emergency responders could 11 mean the difference between life and death when an accident or 12 illness occurs; and

13 WHEREAS, An agreement should be reached that will eliminate 14 the hazards caused by the at-grade crossings; and

15 WHEREAS, It is of critical importance to eliminate the 16 multiple at-grade crossings delays to emergence responders; 17 and

18 WHEREAS, Eliminating these delays would improve emergency 19 response times and economic development in the affected areas 20 of the City of Centralia, the City of Wamac, and the Village of HR1002 -2- LRB098 20849 GRL 58252 r Central City; therefore, be it
