Section 5. The Community Youth Employment Act is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

- Sec. 5. Program; eligibility. Subject to appropriation, the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity shall administer a competitive grant program that will provide 5,000 youths with stipends or wages, or both, and supervision for up to a 52-week, year-round 10-week summer work period. The grants shall be awarded only to summer programs, of no more than 100 youths, that:
 - (1) are created and administered by a community-based organization, not-for-profit organization, educational institution, or governmental entity in Illinois;
- 17 (2) employ low-income youths in Illinois between the 18 ages of 14 and 21; and
- 19 (3) involve age-appropriate, ability-appropriate, and experience-appropriate:
- 21 (A) job training;
- 22 (B) life skills;
- (C) education counseling;

2 (E) supervised meaningful work experience
