

98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 SB1352

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3005/6.02 new

Amends the Governor's Office of Management and Budget Act. Provides that the Governor's Office of Management and Budget shall create, on its official Internet website, an electronic database to allow any State agency or nonprofit vendor to submit grant agreements and grant-related documents electronically and to provide for the public display of those documents on its website. Provides that any nonprofit vendor that is incapable of electronically filing its grant agreements and grant-related documents shall submit a written statement to the Office attesting to the reasons for its inability to do so, and that statement shall be published by the Office on the database. Provides that the Office shall update the database as additional information becomes available in a format that can be compiled and published on the database by the Office. Provides that each State agency shall cooperate with the Office in furnishing the information necessary for the implementation of this Section within a timeframe specified by the Office. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Governor's Office of Management and Budget

 Act is amended by adding Section 6.02 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3005/6.02 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6.02. Grant agreement database.</u>
- 8 (a) For the purposes of this Section, "State agency" means
 9 the offices of the constitutional officers identified in
 10 Article V of the Illinois Constitution, executive agencies, and
 11 departments, boards, commissions, and authorities under the
- 12 Governor.
- (b) Beginning January 1, 2014, the Office shall create, on 13 14 its official Internet website, an electronic database to allow any State agency or nonprofit vendor to submit grant agreements 15 16 and grant-related documents electronically and to provide for 17 the public display of those documents on its website. All grant agreements and all grant-related documents, including progress 18 19 reports, status updates, and final reports that nonprofit 20 vendors are required to submit to the State, such as those 21 filed pursuant to the Illinois Grant Funds Recovery Act, shall 22 be submitted electronically to, and displayed publicly on, the database. Any nonprofit vendor that is incapable of 2.3

- 1 electronically filing its grant agreements and grant-related
- 2 documents shall submit a written statement to the Office
- 3 attesting to the reasons for its inability to do so, and that
- 4 statement shall be published by the Office on the database.
- 5 Nothing in this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly
- 6 <u>shall be construed to impede the implementation of an</u>
- 7 Enterprise Resource Planning system.
- 8 (c) The database created under subsection (b) shall include
- 9 all information required to be published by subsection (b) that
- 10 is available to the Office in a format the Office can compile
- and publish on the database. The Office shall update the
- 12 database as additional information becomes available in a
- format that can be compiled and published on the database by
- the Office.
- 15 (d) Each State agency shall cooperate with the Office in
- 16 furnishing the information necessary for the implementation of
- this Section within a timeframe specified by the Office.
- 18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 19 becoming law.
