Amend Senate Bill 1955, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 2, as follows: 4 on page 1, line 6, after "85,", by inserting "95,"; and 5 6 on page 24, line 22, by replacing " $\underline{3}$ " with " $\underline{2}$ "; and on page 28, immediately below line 21, by inserting the 7 following: 9 "(410 ILCS 130/95) 10 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018) 11 Sec. 95. Background checks. (a) The Department of Agriculture through the Department of 12 13 State Police shall conduct a fingerprint-based criminal background check of the prospective cultivation center agents. 14

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1 Each prospective cultivation center agent shall submit his or her fingerprints to the Department of State Police in the form and manner prescribed by the Department of State Police. These fingerprints shall be checked against the fingerprint records filed in the Department of State Police and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history records databases. Department of State Police shall furnish, pursuant to positive identification, all Illinois conviction information to the Department of Agriculture. The Department of State Police shall be reimbursed for the cost of the background check by the Department of Agriculture. In order to carry out provision, each person applying as a cultivation center agent shall submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of obtaining a State and federal criminal records check. The Department of Agriculture 16 exchange this data with the Department of State Police and the 17 Federal Bureau of Investigation without disclosing that the records check is related to this Act. The Department Agriculture shall destroy each set of fingerprints after criminal records check is complete.

(b) When applying for the initial permit, the background checks for the principal officer, board members, and registered agents shall be completed prior to submitting the application to the Department of Agriculture.

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1 on page 34, by replacing lines 11 through 25 with the 2 following: 3 shall conduct a "Regulation fingerprint-based criminal background check of the prospective dispensing organization 4 5 agents in order to carry out this provision. Each prospective 6 dispensing organization agent shall submit his or her fingerprints to the Department of State Police in the form and 7 manner prescribed by the Department of State Police. These 8 9 fingerprints shall be checked against the fingerprint records 10 filed in the Department of State Police and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history records databases. 11 The Department of State Police shall furnish, pursuant to positive 12 identification, all Illinois conviction information to the 13 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. 14 15 Department of State Police shall be reimbursed for the cost of 16 the background check by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. Each person applying as a dispensing 17 organization agent shall submit a full set of fingerprints to 18 the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation for 19 20 purpose of obtaining a state and federal criminal records check. The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation 21 22 may exchange this data with the Department of State Police and 23 the Federal Bureau of Investigation without disclosing that the records check is related to this Act. The Department of 24 25 Financial and Professional Regulation shall destroy each set of

fingerprints after the criminal records check is completed.".
