23     Section 115. The sum of \$2,318,300, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cemetery  
2 Oversight Licensing and Disciplinary Fund to the Department  
3 of Financial and Professional Regulation for all costs  
4 associated with administration of the Cemetery Oversight Act.

5 Section 120. The sum of \$393,700, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Community  
7 Association Manager Licensing and Disciplinary Fund to the  
8 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation for all  
9 costs associated with administration of the Community  
10 Association Manager Licensing and Disciplinary Act.

11 Section 125. The sum of \$19,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of  
13 Financial and Professional Regulation from the Real Estate  
14 Research and Education Fund for costs associated with the  
15 operation of the Office of Real Estate Research at the  
16 University of Illinois.

17 Section 130. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Athletics  
19 Supervision and Regulation Fund to the Department of  
20 Financial and Professional Regulation for all costs  
21 associated with administration of the Boxing and Full-contact  
22 Martial Arts Act.

1           Section 135. The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Savings  
3 Institutions Regulatory Fund to the Department of Financial  
4 and Professional Regulation for the ordinary and contingent  
5 expenses of the Department of Financial and Professional  
6 Regulation and the Division of Banking, or their successors,  
7 in administering and enforcing the Illinois Savings and Loan  
8 Act of 1985, the Savings Bank Act, and other laws, rules, and  
9 regulations as may apply to the administration and  
10 enforcement of the foregoing laws, rules, and regulations, as  
11 amended from time to time.

12           Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
13 2013.
