

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State Board
7 of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and not,
8 under any circumstances, for personal services expenditures
9 or other operational or administrative costs, are
10 appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
11 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013:

 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois State
 3 Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
 4 2013:

7 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 9 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
 10 Illinois Coalition Immigrant and Refugee Rights' Parent
 11 Mentor Program.

12 Section 25. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 14 Fund for deposit into the School District Emergency Financial
 15 Assistance Fund for use by the State Board of Education, as
 16 provided by 1B-8 of the School Code.

17 Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 19 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
 20 ordinary and contingent expenses of the East St. Louis School
 21 District 189.

1 Section 35. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for targeted
 4 initiatives.

5 Section 40. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Downstate Transit
 7 Improvement Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for
 8 grants to Local Education Agencies to conduct Agriculture
 9 Education Programs.

10 Section 45. If and only if House Bill 208 becomes law
 11 then Section 35 of Article 2 of that bill is amended as
 12 follows:

13 "Section 35. The sum of \$27,400,000, or so much thereof
 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 15 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for Student
 16 Assessments, including Bilingual Assessments-:

17	<u>For writing assessments in</u>	
18	<u>Grade 11</u>	<u>\$2,530,000</u>
19	<u>For Student Assessments including</u>	
20	<u>Bilingual Assessments</u>	<u>\$24,870,000"</u>

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2013.
