1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2555

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2555, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with
4 the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State Board
8 of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and not,
9 under any circumstances, for personal services expenditures
10 or other operational or administrative costs, are
11 appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
12 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013:

12 Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
13 2013:

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16 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
19 Illinois Coalition Immigrant and Refugee Rights' Parent
20 Mentor Program.

21 Section 25. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund for deposit into the School District Emergency Financial
2 Assistance Fund for use by the State Board of Education, as
3 provided by 1B-8 of the School Code.

4 Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
7 ordinary and contingent expenses of the East St. Louis School
8 District 189.

9 Section 35. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for targeted
12 initiatives.

13 Section 40. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Downstate Transit
15 Improvement Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for
16 grants to Local Education Agencies to conduct Agriculture
17 Education Programs.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
19 1, 2013.”.
