- "Organ" means any biological tissue of the human body that 1

- part-time employee who has been employed by an agency for a 6

- 11 Sec. 20. Administration of Act.
- (a) On request, but subject to the operating needs of the 12
- 13 employing agency, a participating employee subject to this Act
- 14 may be entitled to organ donation leave with pay.
- 15 (b) An employee may use (i) up to 30 days of organ donation
- 16 leave in any 12-month period to serve as a bone marrow donor,
- (ii) up to 30 days of organ donation leave in any 12-month 17
- 18 period to serve as an organ donor, and (iii) time, as set forth
- by Department rule, to donate blood, up to one hour or more to 19
- 20 donate blood every 56 days, and (iv) up to 2 hours or more to
- 21 donate blood platelets in accordance with appropriate medical
- 22 standards established by the American Red Cross, America's
- Blood Centers, the American Association of Blood Banks, or 23
