SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 275/40 new

Amends the Workplace Violence Prevention Act. Provides that the Act does not apply to the monitoring of compliance with certain worker safety laws, lawful picketing, or the exercise of the right of free speech or assembly that is otherwise lawful. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Workplace Violence Prevention Act is amended by adding Section 40 as follows:

- 8 This Act does not apply to any individual or 9 organization (i) monitoring or attentive to compliance with public or worker safety laws, wage and hour requirements, or 10 other statutory requirements or (ii) picketing, patrolling, 11 using a banner, or otherwise protesting, occurring at the 12 workplace that is otherwise lawful and arises out of a bona 13 14 fide labor dispute including any controversy concerning wages, salaries, hours, working conditions or benefits, including 15 health and welfare, sick leave, insurance, and pension or 16 17 retirement provisions, the making or maintaining of collective bargaining agreements, and the terms to be included in those 18
- 20 (b) This Act does not apply to an exercise of the right of 21 free speech or assembly that is otherwise lawful.
