13	paragraph, "individual provide:	r" means a person providing
14	services under the Home Service	es Program who is a personal
15	assistant, registered nurse,	licensed practical nurse,
16	certified nurse assistant, occ	upational therapist, physical
17	therapist, or speech therapist a	nd has been privately hired by

2	Any new person providing services as an individual provider	
3	under the Department's Home Services Program shall participate	
4	in a comprehensive in-person orientation, including fraud	
5	training.	
6	Any person providing services as an individual provider	
7	under the Department's Home Services Program shall attend	
8	annual in-person training, including training in preventing	
9	fraud and abuse.	
10	Individual providers shall be paid their regular hourly	
11	wage for all orientation and training hours.".
