Creates the Nursing Home Residents' Managed Care Rights Act. Contains a short title provision and a provision on findings. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning nursing home residents' rights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the 4
- 5 Nursing Home Residents' Managed Care Rights Act.
- 6 Section 5. Findings. The General Assembly finds that
- 7 elderly Illinoisans residing in nursing homes have the right
- 8 to:

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- 9 (1) Quality health care regardless of the payer.
- (2) Care prescribed by their doctor. 10
- 11 (3) A simple appeals process when care is denied.
- 12 (4) Make decisions about their care.
- (5) Continue to live in the care center they call home. 13
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law. 15
