## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 11-1432 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new)
- 7 Sec. 11-1432. Animals in driver's lap.
- 8 (a) A driver may not hold an animal in his or her lap while
- 9 operating a motor vehicle. This Section shall not apply to the
- following motor vehicles as defined by this Code:
- 11 <u>(1) commercial motor vehicles;</u>
- 12 (2) farm tractors;
- 13 (3) implements of husbandry; and
- 14 (4) farm to market agricultural transportation.
- (b) A person who violates this Section is quilty of a petty
- offense and subject to a fine not to exceed \$25.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> A law enforcement officer may not stop or search a
- 18 <u>motor vehicle</u>, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
- because of a violation or suspected violation of this Section.
- Section 10. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 21 amended by changing Section 108-1 as follows:

- 1 (725 ILCS 5/108-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 108-1)
- 2 Sec. 108-1. Search without warrant.
- 3 (1) When a lawful arrest is effected a peace officer may 4 reasonably search the person arrested and the area within such 5 person's immediate presence for the purpose of:
  - (a) protecting the officer from attack; or
- 7 (b) preventing the person from escaping; or
- 8 (c) discovering the fruits of the crime; or
- 9 (d) discovering any instruments, articles, or things
  10 which may have been used in the commission of, or which may
  11 constitute evidence of, an offense.

- 13 (3) A law enforcement officer may not search or inspect a 14 motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely 15 because of a violation of Section 12-603.1 of the Illinois 16 Vehicle Code.
- 17 (4) A law enforcement officer may not stop or search a

  18 motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely

  19 because of a violation or suspected violation of Section

  20 11-1432 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
