SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-44010 55 ILCS 5/5-44060 new

Amends the Counties Code. Extends the applicability provision of the Division to all counties within the State (currently, only DuPage County). Adds a Section concerning the rights of employees of a former unit of local government after it has been dissolved into the governmental unit assuming the functions of the former unit of local government. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section 5-44010 and by adding Section 5-44060 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-44010)
- 7 Sec. 5-44010. Applicability. The powers and authorities
- 8 provided by this Division 5-44 apply to all counties within the
- 9 State only to counties with a population of more than 900,000
- and less than 3,000,000 that are contiguous to a county with a
- 11 population of more than 3,000,000 and units of local government
- 12 within such counties.

- 15 Sec. 5-44060. Rights of former employees. On the effective
- date of dissolution, the employees of the former unit of local
- 17 government shall be transferred to the governmental unit
- assuming the functions of the former unit of local government.
- 19 The governmental unit assuming the functions of the former unit
- 20 of local government shall exercise the rights and
- 21 responsibilities of the former unit of local government with
- 22 <u>respect to those employees. The status and rights of the</u>

- 1 employees of the former unit of local government under any
- 2 <u>applicable contracts or collective bargaining agreements</u>,
- 3 historical representation rights under the Illinois Public
- 4 Labor Relations Act, or under any pension, retirement, or
- 5 annuity plan shall not be affected by this amendatory Act.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
