SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3918/55

Amends the Illinois Building Commission Act. Provides that, at least 30 days prior to filing rules pertaining to the adoption or amendment of any statewide code pertaining to building construction, each State agency must provide notice to the Illinois Building Commission. Provides that the Commission must identify the proposed code, by the title and edition, or by the amendment, to the public on the Internet. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Building Commission Act is amended
5 by changing Section 55 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3918/55)

7 Sec. 55. Identification of local building codes. Beginning
8 on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 92nd
9 General Assembly, a municipality with a population of less than
10 1,000,000 or a county adopting a new building code or amending
11 an existing building code must, at least 30 days before
12 adopting the code or amendment, provide an identification of
13 the code, by title and edition, or the amendment to the
14 Commission. The Commission must identify the proposed code, by
15 the title and edition, or the amendment to the public on the
16 Internet through the State of Illinois World Wide Web site.

17 A municipality with a population of less than 1,000,000 or
18 county shall provide notice of the title and editions of any
19 adopted building codes to the Capital Development Board,
20 Division of Building Codes and Regulations, prior to July 1,
21 2011. The notice shall be electronic whenever possible and also
22 contain the division of government, the name of contact, and
23 the date of the adoption of the codes.

1 Each State agency, at least 30 days prior to filing rules
2 pertaining to the adoption or amendment of any statewide code
3 pertaining to building construction, including accessibility,
4 energy, plumbing, and life safety with the Secretary of State
5 for publication in the Illinois Register, must provide notice
6 to the Commission by identifying the code by title, by an
7 edition, or by the amendment. The Commission must identify the
8 proposed code, by the title and edition, or the amendment, to
9 the public on the Internet through the State of Illinois World
10 Wide Web site.

11 The Commission may adopt any rules necessary to implement
12 this Section.

13 For the purposes of this Section, "building code" means any
14 municipal or county ordinance or resolution regulating the
15 construction and maintenance of all structures within the
16 municipality or county.
