SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/3a

from Ch. 38, par. 83-3a

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that a resident of any other state who is 18 years of age or older and who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the state of his or her domicile, or the United States from obtaining, possessing, or using a firearm, may purchase or obtain ammunition for a rifle or shotgun in Illinois. Provides that a resident of any other state who is 21 years of age or older and who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the state of his or her domicile, or the United States from obtaining, possessing, or using a firearm, may purchase or obtain ammunition for a handgun in Illinois.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 3a as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/3a) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-3a)
- Sec. 3a. (a) Any resident of Illinois who has obtained a firearm owner's identification card pursuant to this Act and who is not otherwise prohibited from obtaining, possessing or using a firearm may purchase or obtain a rifle or shotgun or ammunition for a rifle or shotgun in Iowa, Missouri, Indiana, Wisconsin or Kentucky.
 - (b) Any resident of Iowa, Missouri, Indiana, Wisconsin or Kentucky or a non-resident with a valid non-resident hunting license, who is 18 years of age or older and who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the state of his domicile, or the United States from obtaining, possessing or using a firearm, may purchase or obtain a rifle, shotgun or ammunition for a rifle or shotgun in Illinois.
- 20 (b-1) A resident of any other state who is 18 years of age 21 or older and who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the 22 state of his or her domicile, or the United States from 23 obtaining, possessing, or using a firearm, may purchase or

- 1 <u>obtain ammunition for a rifle or shotgun in Illinois.</u>
- 2 (b-2) A resident of any other state who is 21 years of age
- 3 or older and who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the
- 4 state of his or her domicile, or the United States from
- 5 <u>obtaining</u>, possessing, or using a firearm, may purchase or
- 6 <u>obtain ammunition for a handgun in Illinois.</u>
- 7 (b-5) Any non-resident who is participating in a sanctioned
- 8 competitive shooting event, who is 18 years of age or older and
- 9 who is not prohibited by the laws of Illinois, the state of his
- 10 or her domicile, or the United States from obtaining,
- 11 possessing, or using a firearm, may purchase or obtain a
- 12 shotgun or shotgun ammunition in Illinois for the purpose of
- participating in that event. A person may purchase or obtain a
- 14 shotgun or shotgun ammunition under this subsection only at the
- 15 site where the sanctioned competitive shooting event is being
- 16 held.
- 17 (c) Any transaction under this Section is subject to the
- provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968 (18 U.S.C. 922
- 19 (b) (3)).
