SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/143.30a new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that automobile insurers shall not specify or require any motor vehicle repair shop to utilize specific products, vendors, distributors, manufacturers, or suppliers in order to carry out vehicle repairs for an insured or claimant.

1 AN ACT concerning insurance.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding
5 Section 143.30a as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/143.30a new)

7 Sec. 143.30a. Selection of replacement or repair
8 companies. With reference to every policy of automobile
9 insurance, as defined in subsection (a) of Section 143.13 of
10 this Code, an automobile insurer authorized to do business in
11 this State shall not specify or require any motor vehicle
12 repair shop to utilize specific products, vendors,
13 distributors, manufacturers, or suppliers in order to carry out
14 vehicle repairs for an insured or claimant. The terms of
15 pricing agreements an insurer has negotiated with
16 distributors, manufacturers, or suppliers of products, parts,
17 supplies, or materials used for vehicle repair may not be
18 imposed on a motor vehicle repair shop.
