### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for FY16 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services .....	\$16,239,094
10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	1,230,923
11	For Contractual Services .....	2,162,000
12	For Travel .....	65,000
13	For Commodities .....	44,000
14	For Printing .....	45,000
15	For Equipment .....	46,000
16	For EDP .....	927,483
17	For Telecommunications .....	277,500
18	For Law Student Program .....	<u>65,000</u>
19	Total .....	\$21,102,000

20 Section 10. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Appellate

1 Defender Federal Trust Fund to the Office of the State  
2 Appellate Defender for expenses related to federally-assisted  
3 programs to work on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases  
4 to which the agency is appointed.

5 Section 15. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for  
8 expenses related to federally-assisted programs to work on  
9 systemic sentencing issues appeals cases to which the agency  
10 is appointed.

11 Section 20. The amount of \$160,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
13 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the  
14 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

15 Section 25. The amount of \$63,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
17 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide  
18 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public  
19 Defender Training Program.

20 Section 30. The amount of \$315,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop  
2 a Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
4 2015.
