A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. "AN ACT making appropriations", Public Act 98-
6 0680, approved June 30, 2014, is amended by changing Section
7 10 of Article 9 as follows:

8 (P.A. 98-0680, Art. 9, Sec. 10)

9 Sec. 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
11 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
12 Department of Human Services for income assistance and
13 related distributive purposes, including such Federal funds
14 as are made available by the Federal Government for the
15 following purposes:

19 For Aid to Aged, Blind or Disabled

11 The Department, with the consent in writing from the
12 Governor, may reappropriation not more than ten percent of the
13 total appropriation of General Revenue Funds in Section 5
14 above "For Income Assistance and Related Distributive
15 Purposes" among the various purposes therein enumerated.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17 becoming law.
