A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 OPERATIONAL EXPENSES

6 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated,
7 the amount of \$10,444,100, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General

17 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
 18 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
 19 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
 20 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
