ARTICLE 4

3 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 4 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General 5 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 6 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
