The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 8 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority 9 for the purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative 10 expenses and all related costs for the Safe From the Start 11 Program.
