HOUSE RESOLUTION

2           WHEREAS, The Barack Obama Foundation is currently in the  
3 process of selecting a location for construction of the  
4 President Barack Obama Presidential Library and Museum; and

5           WHEREAS, The final 4 locations being considered are one  
6 location in New York, one in Hawaii, and 2 within the City of  
7 Chicago - one on the West Side at the University of Illinois at  
8 Chicago and one on the South Side at the University of Chicago;  
9 and

10           WHEREAS, Chicago is the largest city in the State of  
11 Illinois and Illinois is the State where President Obama served  
12 in the Senate from 1997 through 2004, representing the 13th  
13 Legislative District; and

14           WHEREAS, The City of Chicago is President Obama's hometown;  
15 it is where he started both his career in public service and  
16 his family, and it is where his family still calls home;  
17 Chicago has seen its profile as a global city grow and has seen  
18 increased economic and cultural development by having the  
19 President of the United States hail from within its borders;  
20 and

21           WHEREAS, In support of Chicago's 2 bids, the 98th Illinois

1 General Assembly passed Public Act 98-1005, which provides for  
2 the loan or donation to a presidential library or museum any  
3 books, items, furniture, equipment, or other materials or  
4 property of former Illinois State Senator Barack Obama in the  
5 possession or control of the Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, The Barack Obama Foundation is scheduled to select  
7 the final site by the end of March of 2015; therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
9 NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we  
10 urge the Barack Obama Foundation to select one of the 2 Chicago  
11 bids as the location to build the President Barack Obama  
12 Presidential Library and Museum; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be  
14 delivered to President Barack Obama, First Lady Michelle Obama,  
15 and the Barack Obama Foundation board members.
