1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, All citizens of Illinois should be made aware of
- 3 the ever-present dangers posed by potentially poisonous
- 4 household substances; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Children too often have access to
- 6 over-the-counter and prescription medications and potentially
- 7 toxic household products; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Over the past 50 years, the nation has been
- 9 observing National Poison Prevention Week to help prevent
- 10 accidental poisonings and tips for promoting community
- involvement in poison prevention; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Illinois Poison Center has been providing
- timely poison prevention and treatment services to the people
- 14 of Illinois for over 60 years as the oldest and one of the
- largest poison centers in the nation; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Illinois Poison Center is a mainstay in the
- 17 emergency medical care system of the State of Illinois and is
- 18 recognized nationally for its contributions to poisor
- 19 treatment and prevention; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Forty-five percent of the more than 80,000

- 1 poisonings reported last year to the Illinois Poison Center
- 2 involved children under the age of 5 and could have been
- 3 prevented; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Illinois Poison Center manages approximately
- 5 90% of cases from the general public at home, saving the State
- 6 of Illinois over \$60 million in reduced health care and lost
- 7 productivity costs; therefore, be it
- 8 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 9 NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
- designate March of 2016 as Poison Prevention Month in the State
- of Illinois and urge all Illinoisans to educate themselves
- 12 about the potentially harmful substances in their homes and
- 13 take steps to create healthy and safe home, play, and work
- 14 environments; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- presented to the Illinois Poison Center.
