1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Each year sudden cardiac arrest claims the lives 2 3 of approximately 383,000 Americans outside of the hospital; it 4 strikes people of all levels of fitness, and it usually strikes 5 without warning; and

- 6 WHEREAS, In many cases, sudden cardiac arrest is caused by 7 an abnormal heart rhythm called ventricular fibrillation that 8 prevents the heart from pumping blood; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The treatment for ventricular fibrillation is 10 defibrillation, which is the delivery of an electric shock to 11 the heart that stops ventricular fibrillation and allows a 12 normal heart rhythm to resume; and
- 13 Providing defibrillation on-site WHEREAS, with an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) can 14 significantly increase survival rates for ventricular fibrillation cardiac 15 16 arrest; and
- WHEREAS, The American Heart Association is a national voluntary health agency whose mission is to reduce disability and death from cardiovascular diseases and stroke, and it is dedicated to helping businesses and communities establish 21 on-site AED programs; and
