1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 572

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 572 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources Act is
5 amended by changing Sections 20-5 and 20-15 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 801/20-5)

7 Sec. 20-5. State Museum. The State shall operate an
8 Illinois State Museum in Springfield and at branch sites
9 determined by the Department of Natural Resources in
10 collaboration with units of local government. The Illinois
11 State Museum and all branch sites shall be open to the public.
12 The Illinois State Museum shall operate a research and
13 collections center to research, preserve, and maintain access
14 to the extensive Illinois State Museum collections. The
15 Department of Natural Resources shall have within it the office
16 of the Illinois State Museum. The Board of the Illinois State

1 Museum is retained as the advisory governing board for the
2 State Museum. The Department of Natural Resources and the Board
3 of the Illinois State Museum shall solicit the assistance of
4 the Illinois State Museum Society and units of local government
5 to fundraise non-State resources for the museum.

7 (20 ILCS 801/20-15)

8 Sec. 20-15. Entrance fee; private contracting.

9 (a) The Department may set, by the Director, by
10 administrative rule an entrance fee for visitors to the
11 Illinois State Museum. A different fee may be charged for
12 different classes of visitors. The fee assessed by this Section
13 shall be deposited into the Illinois State Museum Fund for the
14 Department to use to support the Illinois State Museum. The
15 monies deposited into the Illinois State Museum Fund under this
16 Section shall not be subject to administrative charges or
17 chargebacks unless otherwise authorized by this Act.

18 (b) On and after the effective date of this amendatory Act
19 of the 99th General Assembly, the State shall not contract with
20 a private contractor or private vendor for services relating to
21 the operation of the Illinois State Museum or its collections;
22 however, this amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly does
23 not apply to contracts for ancillary services or other services
24 not directly related to the ownership, management, or operation
25 of the Illinois State Museum or its collections.
