SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/1530

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. In provisions concerning the written examination for a public adjuster license, reduces the waiting period for retaking the examination for an individual who fails from 90 days to 7 days.

1 AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 1530 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/1530)
- 7 Sec. 1530. Examination.
- 8 (a) An individual applying for a public adjuster license
 9 under this Article must pass a written examination unless he or
 10 she is exempt pursuant to Section 1535 of this Article. The
 11 examination shall test the knowledge of the individual
 12 concerning the duties and responsibilities of a public adjuster
 13 and the insurance laws and regulations of this State.
 14 Examinations required by this Section shall be developed and
- 15 conducted under rules and regulations prescribed by the
- 16 Director.
- 17 The Director make (b) may arrangements, including contracting with an outside testing service, for administering 18 19 examinations and collecting the nonrefundable fee. 20 individual applying for an examination shall remit 21 nonrefundable fee as prescribed by the Director. An individual 22 who fails to appear for the examination as scheduled or fails to pass the examination shall reapply for an examination and 2.3

- 1 remit all required fees and forms before being rescheduled for
- 2 another examination. An individual who fails to pass the
- 3 examination must wait $\frac{7}{2}$ $\frac{90}{2}$ days prior to rescheduling an
- 4 examination.
