1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Revenue Law of the Civil
 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
- 6 2505-760 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2505/2505-760 new)
- 8 Sec. 2505-760. Surrender of property; indemnification.
- 9 (a) Any person or entity in possession of, or obligated
- with respect to, property or rights to property subject to
- levy, upon which a levy has been made, who, upon demand by the
- 12 Director, surrenders such property or rights to property or
- discharges such obligation to the Director shall, at the
- 14 Director's discretion, be discharged from any obligation or
- 15 <u>liability to the delinquent taxpayer and any other person with</u>
- 16 respect to such property or rights to property arising from
- such surrender or payment, but not in an amount in excess of
- the amount of property or rights to property surrendered to the
- 19 <u>Director</u>.
- 20 (b) The General Assembly recognizes that financial
- 21 <u>institutions</u>, as defined by Section 2 of the Illinois Banking
- 22 Act, are in a unique position to assist with the identification
- of fraud pertaining to refunds deposited in their accounts. The

1 General Assembly further recognizes that, due to the 2 relationship between financial institutions and their 3 customers, financial institutions are reluctant to turn over 4 funds they have identified as fraudulent without assurances 5 that they will not be held liable in the event that refunds 6 were identified as fraud in error. In order to facilitate the 7 recapture of refunds that have been identified as having been issued as a result of fraud, the Department has the authority, 8 9 but is not required, to indemnify any financial institution that returns funds to the Department at the request of the 10 11 Director based on the bona fide belief that the funds held by 12 the financial institution were deposited as a result of fraud 13 committed against another taxpayer, the Department, or another 14 agency of the State of Illinois.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
