

## 99TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2015 and 2016 SB2197

Introduced 12/4/2015, by Sen. Scott M. Bennett

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Department of Transportation, the Illinois Gaming Board, the Department of the Lottery, the Department of State Police, the Illinois Commerce Commission the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, and the Department of Revenue from Other State Funds for various essential services including emergency telephone services, lottery payments, and payments to local governments. Effective immediately.

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1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5	as are available for distribution in accordance with Section
6	8 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor
7	Fuel Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the
8	purposes stated:

10	For apportioning, allotting, and paying
11	as provided by law:

13	To Municipalities
14	To Counties for Distribution to

16	Total \$582,500,000
17	Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof
18	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming
19	Fund to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local
20	governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior
21	year costs.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes 3 to holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including 4 prizes related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of 5 6 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of 7 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois 8 Lottery Law.

- 9 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service 11 12 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911 13 Administrator Program.
- 14 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1 16 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to 17 the Emergency Telephone System Act.
- 18 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof 19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless 20 Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission 21 for its administrative costs and for grants to emergency 22 telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or

- 1 the Department of State Police for the design,
- 2 implementation, operation, maintenance, or upgrade of
- 3 wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and public safety
- 4 answering points.
- 5 Section 35. The Department of Commerce and Economic
- 6 Opportunity, with the consent in writing from the Governor,
- 7 may reapportion not more than ten percent of the total
- 8 appropriation of Tourism Promotion Fund, in Section 20 above,
- 9 among the various purposes therein recommended.
- 10 Payable from Local Tourism Fund:
- 11 For grants to Convention and Tourism Bureaus
- 13 For grants, contracts, and administrative
- 14 expenses associated with the
- 15 Local Tourism and Convention Bureau
- 16 Program pursuant to 20 ILCS 605/605-705

- 19 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof
- 20 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
- 21 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
- 22 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of
