1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2289

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2289 on page 1, by  
3 replacing line 20 with "Sections 10-7, 10-25, 20-7, 20-10,  
4 27-10, 27-13, 28-10, and 28-13 as follows:"; and

5 on page 1, immediately after line 20, by inserting the  
6 following:

7 "(60 ILCS 1/10-7 new)

8 Sec. 10-7. Cost and services study. Prior to certifying and  
9 causing a proposition to be submitted to the voters under  
10 Section 10-5, the county board and township board shall conduct  
11 or have conducted a cost and services study detailing the  
12 fiscal and services impact the altering of township boundaries  
13 would have on the taxpayers of the county and township. Any  
14 such cost and services study shall be completed on or before 45  
15 days after adoption of an ordinance or resolution for a  
16 referendum has been adopted under Section 10-5. After receipt

1 of the cost and services study by the county board, and no  
2 later than 60 days after adoption of an ordinance or resolution  
3 for a referendum has been adopted under Section 10-5, the  
4 county board shall certify and cause the referendum to be  
5 submitted to the voters of the county to alter township  
6 boundaries as provided in Section 10-5."; and

7 on page 2, immediately after line 23, by inserting the  
8 following:

9 "(60 ILCS 1/20-7 new)

10 Sec. 20-7. Cost and services study. Prior to certifying and  
11 causing a proposition to be submitted to the voters under  
12 Section 20-5, the township boards of the townships being  
13 consolidated shall conduct or have conducted a cost and  
14 services study detailing the fiscal and services impact the  
15 consolidation of the townships would have on the taxpayers of  
16 the county and townships. Any such cost and services study  
17 shall be completed on or before 45 days after adoption receipt  
18 of a petition under Section 20-5. After receipt of the cost and  
19 services study by the county board and township boards, and no  
20 later than 60 days after receipt of a petition under Section  
21 20-5, the township boards shall certify and cause the  
22 proposition to be submitted to the voters of the townships to  
23 consolidate the townships as provided in Section 20-5."; and

1 on page 5, immediately after line 7, by inserting the  
2 following:

3 "(60 ILCS 1/27-13 new)

4 Sec. 27-13. Cost and services study. Prior to certifying  
5 and causing a proposition to be submitted to the voters under  
6 Section 27-10, the city council of the coterminous municipality  
7 that governs the township shall conduct or have conducted a  
8 cost and services study, paid for by the township and  
9 municipality, detailing the fiscal and services impact the  
10 discontinuance of the township would have on the taxpayers of  
11 the township and municipality. Any such cost and services study  
12 shall be completed on or before 45 days after adoption of an  
13 ordinance, or receipt of a petition, under Section 27-10. After  
14 receipt of the cost and services study by the city council, and  
15 no later than 60 days after adoption of an ordinance, or  
16 receipt of a petition, under Section 27-10, the city council  
17 shall certify and cause the proposition to be submitted to the  
18 voters of the township to discontinue and abolish the township  
19 organization as provided in Section 27-10."; and

20 on page 6, immediately after line 18, by inserting the  
21 following:

22 "(60 ILCS 1/28-13 new)

23 Sec. 28-13. Cost and services study. Prior to or after the

1 adoption of an ordinance under Section 28-10, the township  
2 board shall conduct or have conducted a cost and services study  
3 detailing the fiscal and township services impact the  
4 discontinuance of the township organization would have on the  
5 taxpayers of the township. Any such cost and services study  
6 shall be completed no later than 45 days after adoption of an  
7 ordinance under Section 28-10. After receipt of the cost and  
8 services study by the township board, and after adoption of an  
9 ordinance under Section 28-10, the township organization may  
10 cease as provided under this Article."
