1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3336 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 3336 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Pharmacy Practice Act is amended by adding 4 Section 30.1 as follows: 5 6 (225 ILCS 85/30.1 new) 7 Sec. 30.1. Reporting of termination for cause. (a) A pharmacist in charge shall report to the Department 8 within 60 days when a pharmacist, registered certified pharmacy 10 technician, or registered pharmacy technician is terminated from employment for cause, as defined by rule. If a pharmacist 11 12 in charge is terminated by a pharmacy for cause, it shall be 13 the responsibility of the pharmacy to report that termination 14 to the Department within 60 days. 15 (b) The report of a termination for cause shall include documentation of the reason for the termination, including any

prosecution or civil damages.

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- 1 underlying pharmacy records used to reach the decision to 2 terminate, as described by rule.
- 3 (c) Any individual or organization acting in good faith, 4 and not in a willful and wanton manner, in complying with this 5 Section by providing any report or other information to the 6 Department or by participating in proceedings of the Department shall not, as a result of such actions, be subject to criminal 7
- 9 (d) Any information reported or disclosed shall be kept for 10 the confidential use of the Department and shall not be 11 disclosed to anyone other than as provided in Section 2105-117 of the Department of Professional Regulation Law of the Civil 12 13 Administrative Code of Illinois.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 15 becoming law.".
