WHEREAS, Murray Conzelman was born in Waukegan on November 2, 1929 to Murray Wilson and Jesse Edwards Conzelman; he graduated from Waukegan High School, Lake Forest College, and the Northwestern University School of Law; he married Barbara Vasey in 1955; and

WHEREAS, Murray Conzelman started practicing law in 1953; he was elected Alderman of the 7th Ward for the City of Waukegan at the age of 23 and is the youngest person to have ever been elected to that position; he was appointed by the Illinois Supreme Court to its Rules Committee and served in that capacity for many years; he was a founding member of the Jefferson Inn, an American Inn of Court; and
