WHEREAS, Lloyd Maday was married in 1960 after a whirlwind engagement and lived in Chicago for 6 years before settling in Evanston; and

WHEREAS, Lloyd Maday and the shop became fixtures in the community, highlighted by Maday coaching in Little League, coaching football and baseball at St. Athanasius Grade School in Evanston, and mentoring young people interested in cars, all while remaining a committed husband and strong father to his
