SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Sheldon Sternberg of Chicago, who passed 4 away on April 9, 2015; and

5 WHEREAS, Sheldon Sternberg was born in Chicago on February 6 27, 1923; while attending DePaul University in 1942, he 7 enlisted in the United States Air Force and was assigned to the 8 390th Bombardment Squadron; he was sent to Europe, where he served as navigator for bombing missions over Germany and 9 10 France; he also participated in Operation Chowhound, a series 11 of humanitarian missions that included food drops over the 12 Netherlands; and

13 WHEREAS, Sheldon Sternberg returned to Chicago after his 14 military service and joined his wife's family's business, 15 Best's Kosher Sausage Company, which later produced hot dogs 16 served at Wrigley Field and other landmark Chicago venues; he 17 was President of the company in 1993 when it was sold to Sara 18 Lee; and

19 WHEREAS, Sheldon Sternberg was an avid Chicago Cubs fan; 20 and
