WHEREAS, Sondra Hecox was born on August 28, 1936 in Clarion, Iowa; her parents were Irvin and Freda Harmon; she married Dale Hecox on June 7, 1956; and

WHEREAS, Sondra Hecox attended Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa and the American Business Institute; she later worked for the City of Iowa City until her husband completed his education; they then moved to Oak Park, where she worked as Director of Personnel for the Sunbeam Corporation until her first daughter was born, at which time she became a housewife; they then moved to Elmhurst and then finally to Saint Charles in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Sondra Hecox loved the Republican Party and she and her husband came to represent all that was best about the Grand Old Party; senators, congressmen, and political leaders all sought her counsel and approval; she was a tireless Republican advocate and volunteer; she was an elected precinct committeewoman for Saint Charles Township; she served as secretary of the Kane County Republican Women's Organization;

14 was a member of the Pottawatomie Garden Club and participated
