WHEREAS, Carl Raymond was born in Bunker Hill to Carl R. 5 6 and Edith (Schulthes) Raymond on July 16, 1929; he graduated 7 from Bunker Hill High School in 1947 and married Eunice Jean 8 Lenzi in Chesterfield on August 29, 1948; he served with the 9 United States Army, 25th Infantry Division with the Occupation 10 Forces in Japan after World War II; he was later recalled for 11 the Korean Conflict, serving with the 2nd Infantry Division; 12 and

- 15 WHEREAS, Carl Raymond was a 50-year member of the Masonic

 17 lifetime member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #1308 of
 18 Alton; and
