1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Frank A. Cacci, who passed away on 4 September 22, 2016, at the age of 100; and

WHEREAS, Frank Cacci was born on June 29, 1916; he was a member of the Rockford police force in the 1930s; he served as a military police officer during World War II; he was awarded the European-African-Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon with three bronze battle stars for the Invasion of Normandy, the Battle of Stalingrad, and the Battle of the Bulge; in addition, he received the Good Conduct Medal and World War II Victory Medal; and

WHEREAS, After World War II, Frank Cacci moved to Woodstock, where he owned and operated the Woodstock News Agency from the late 1940s through the early 1980s; and

WHEREAS, Frank Cacci enjoyed golfing, playing well into his 90s; he scored a hole-in-one on July 29, 1964 at the Woodstock Country Club and received a 24k gold-plated putter; he was one of the original eight members of Woodstock's VFW Honor Squad founded in 1947 and served as commander from 1949 to 1950; he joined the Elks in 1953 and was awarded life membership in 1983; he served as President of the Woodstock Country Club in
