- AN ACT to amend the Medical Practice Act of 1987.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended
- 5 by adding Section 18.1 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 60/18.1 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 18.1. Faculty permit.</u>
- 8 (a) A faculty permit authorizes the holder to practice
- 9 medicine only within the medical school itself and any
- 10 <u>affiliated</u> institution in which the permit holder is
- 11 providing instruction as part of the medical school's
- 12 <u>educational program and for which the medical school has</u>
- 13 <u>assumed direct responsibility.</u>
- 14 (b) Time spent in a faculty position under a faculty
- 15 permit shall not be counted toward the postgraduate training
- 16 required for licensure and shall not qualify the holder for
- 17 <u>waiver of any written examination required for licensure.</u>
- 18 (c) The Department shall issue a faculty permit to an
- 19 <u>applicant who meets all of the following requirements:</u>
- 20 <u>(1) holds or has been offered a full-time</u>
- 21 appointment at the level of associate professor or higher
- 22 <u>at an Illinois medical school approved by the Department;</u>
- 23 (2) possesses a current valid license to practice
- 24 <u>medicine issued by another state, country, or other</u>
- 25 <u>jurisdiction;</u>
- 26 (3) is not subject to denial for a license under
- 27 <u>this Act; and</u>
- 28 <u>(4) pays the fee prescribed for the permit, as</u>
- 29 <u>determined by the Department.</u>
- 30 (d) An application for a faculty permit shall be made on
- 31 <u>a form prescribed by the Department and shall include any</u>

- 1 <u>information that the Department may prescribe to establish an</u>
- 2 <u>applicant's eligibility for a permit. This information shall</u>
- 3 <u>include without limitation (i) a statement from the dean of</u>
- 4 the medical school at which the applicant will be employed
- 5 <u>describing the applicant's qualifications and (ii) a</u>
- 6 statement from the dean of the medical school listing every
- 7 <u>affiliated institution in which the applicant will be</u>
- 8 providing instruction as part of the medical school's
- 9 <u>education program and justifying any clinical activities at</u>
- 10 <u>each of the institutions listed by the dean.</u>
- 11 (e) The Department may deny, suspend, or revoke a
- 12 <u>faculty permit for any violation that would be grounds for</u>
- discipline under this Act.
- 14 <u>(f) The Department may provide by rule for the</u>
- 15 <u>administration</u> and <u>enforcement</u> of this Section, including
- 16 <u>permit renewal.</u>
